Join the Avian Consensus Project 2026

Shape the Future of Avian Medicine

The VetConsensus Initiative (VCI) is building the next generation of evidence-based, species-specific veterinary pharmacology. Our Avian Consensus Project 2026 develops consensus derived recommendations in Avian Medicine.

We provide clinicians with transparent, consensus-driven therapeutic recommendations that are grounded in peer-reviewed science, structured expert judgement, and internationally recognised GRADE methodology.

Starting with an evidence-focused Delphi review of pilot formulary monographs. Four work streams cover Psittacine, Rabbit, Hedgehog and Chelonian Medicine ensuring a consistent, multi-species framework.

What is involved?

Delphi Panellists will take part in 3–4 structured online survey rounds, each lasting around 20–30 minutes. In each round, you will be asked to assess draft pharmacology monographs against key domains: dose accuracy, clinical suitability, safety profile, and efficacy. Responses are anonymous, and results are iteratively collated and fed back, allowing the group to refine towards consensus. Your input will directly shape consensus-based GRADE scores, creating practical, trustworthy guidance for clinicians in practice worldwide.

Why Participate?

- 1. Influence international best practice in Avian Medicine.
- 2. Gain recognition in consensus publications and cited outputs.
- 3. Contribute to safer, more effective, and transparent clinical decision-making.
- Receive guaranteed access to the pilot formulary during its development and first year of deployment and discounted access to parallel work streams.

Timeline

- Week of 5 January 2026: Launch of the Delphi process all registered panellists receive participation details.
- Quarter 1 2026: Delphi rounds in progress, with blended input across expert groups.
 Easter 2026: Preliminary results shared and submitted for publication; Delphi panellists completing all rounds will be unblinded
- Parallel pilots: Chelonian, Rabbit, and Hedgehog groups following identical protocols.
